SET Plan Process on OneSchool for Students and Parents

The following steps must be completed before the SET Plan Interview.

Step 1 – Accessing the OneSchool student application



or type oslp.eq.edu.au into your address bar.

Sign in with your school MIS Id and password.

Step 2 – Select My SET Plan



Step 3 – Select My Intended Pathway

My Intended Pathway screen consists of 5 questions relating to your intention for schooling and further work or study beyond Year 10.

- Q1. Select one option to indicate intention after completion of Year 10.
- Q2. Select one option to indicate intended learning pathway.
- Q3. Select one or more options to indicate planned achievement of additional pathway options.
- Q4. Select one option to indicate preferred post school pathway.
- Q5. Enter Unique Student Identifier (USI) if known. Select Save.



Step 4 – Select My Pathway Portfolio

You can enter up to 6 Pathway Plans which outline your post-school options.

- 1. Select Add New
- 2. Select Learning Mode from dropdown list.

3. Enter course/location, subject requirements, career/course entry requirements and future employment possibilities.

4. Select Save
