## Subject selection for year 9 into year 10 in 2025

As we start the final school term, we would like to share with students and families the details of subject selection for year 10 in 2025. Below are the Term 4 timelines for student selections. In this email you will receive this letter along with the subject selection structure (year 9 into 10 in 2025) and the ISC Junior Secondary Subject Information Handbook 2025.

Students in year 10 will study:

- English
- Maths
- Science
- History
- Health & physical education

In addition to these compulsory subjects, students have the choice of selecting four semester-long elective subjects, from:

- Agriculture
- Business
- Dance
- Drama
- Fashion
- Geography
- Hospitality
- Industrial Skills – Metal
- Industrial Skills - Wood
- Media Arts
- Music
- Physics & Specialist Maths
- Psychology
- Physical Education\*
- Recreation Studies\*
- Visual Arts

\*Students cannot select both physical education and recreation studies.

Students also have the option of undertaking additional study in the vocational area of Certificate II Sport Coaching (Rugby League focus), offered by TAFE. An expression of interest form is included in this pack.

Students will study these elective subjects for one semester, so it is important students choose subjects that they are interested in from their experience in years 7, 8 and 9 subjects. There is a maximum quota for some subjects, especially in Hospitality, Digital Technologies, and Industrial Skills. Through their successful elective studies, students will also obtain a Certificate II in Active Volunteering, and earning 4 points towards their Qld Certificate of Education (QCE).

Students who have demonstrated an unsatisfactory safety record and/or who have been non-compliant following simple teacher directions may not be allowed to choose some subjects due to the inherent risk involved.

Certain subjects incur a subject resource. These resource costs are listed below and are detailed in the subject information handbook provided with this letter. These costs are listed below, as well as detailed in the subject information handbook provided with this letter. A failure to pay the resource fees and any unpaid school fees may result in a student not being able to begin/continue



in the subject. To arrange a fee payment plan please contact the office between 8.00 am – 4.00 pm on 4078 0222. This should be done prior to your student selecting their subjects.
