INTRODUCTION

Criteria for the Award 2017

- Candidate should be a **Year 12 student**
- He/she must have an **excellent** record **as regards conduct** in Year 12
- He/she must have an **excellent** record **as a role model** for younger students
- There should be no serious "negatives" **as regards punctuality, attendance or in general "letting the side down"**
- He/she must have a good record in relation to **college uniform**
- He/she must have an excellent record (not necessarily the best) in the dimensions of **academic** (particularly effort & behaviour), **sporting** (more than one sport) and **extra curricular** (arts, public speaking, **student council**, school magazine, instrumental music program etc.)
- He/she must **be highly regarded by his/her peers**
- Student could have held **some position of responsibility** in Year 12, eg Council Member, Captain, Vice Captain, Committee Member, Sports House Leader, etc.

Even if a student does not meet all the criteria, his/her name should still be put forward.

Award recipient receives a medallion, a certificate and \$200.

Students may be nominated by:

- Themselves (with teacher endorsement)
- Teachers
- Parent (with teacher endorsement)
