INTRODUCTION

This award is for a student who has produced **meritorious** (exemplary) work.

Suggested Criteria for the Award 2017

- Candidate should be a **Year 11 student**
- He/she must have an **excellent** record **as a role model** for younger students
- He/she must have an **excellent** record **as regards conduct**
- There should be no serious "negatives" as **regards punctuality, attendance or, in general "letting the side down"**
- He/she must have a good record in relation to **college uniform**
- He/she has achieved meritorious grades and excellent conduct
- He/she must have made a solid contribution (but not necessarily the best contribution) **to extracurricular activities**, eg public speaking or debating, school musical, school sport, student council, student leader, Indigenous leader, instrumental music program, academic competitions
- He/she must **be highly regarded by his/her peers.**

Even if a student does not meet all the criteria, his/her name should still be put forward
